# What is the gift of holy spirit?

- God's kind of life
  - John 3:5:
    - <sup>5</sup>Jesus answered, "With-certainty, with-certainty I say to you, except someone may be born from water and spirit he is not able to go into the kingdom of God;
  - Acts 2:1-4:
    - <sup>2:1</sup>And in the fulfillment (*of*) the day of Pentecost they were all together on the same-place, <sup>2</sup>and there became suddenly out-from heaven a sound wholly-as (*the*) carrying of a violent blowing and it filled the whole house where they were sitting-down, <sup>3</sup>and tongues being thoroughly-distributed were seen by them as-though of fire and it sat-down on each one of them, <sup>4</sup>and they were all filled of holy spirit, and they began to utter-forth with different tongues according as the spirit gave to them (*the words*) to precisely-speak-out.

# The resurrected Christ

- The essence of the resurrected Christ is the spirit of holiness
  - Romans 1:3 and 4:
    - .<sup>3</sup>concerning His son – the (*son*) having come-into-being out-from (*the*) seed of David according to (*the*) flesh,  
.<sup>4</sup>the (*son*) having been marked-out-definitely (*as being*) God's son in ability according to (*the*) spirit of holiness out-from (*the*) resurrection of dead-people – Jesus Christ our Lord,

# Who gives the gift of holy spirit?

- God gives the gift of holy spirit to mankind by means of the Lord Jesus Christ
  - Acts 2:32 and 33:
    - .<sup>32</sup>this Jesus God resurrected of whom we all are witnesses, .<sup>33</sup>therefore having been heightened to the right-side of God and having received the promise of the spirit, the holy (*spirit*), from the Father, he poured-out this which you observe and hear,

# Who receives the gift of holy spirit?

- People of any background can receive the gift of holy spirit
  - Acts 2:37-39:
    - <sup>.37</sup>... "What may we do, adult-males, brothers?" <sup>.38</sup>And Peter (*said*) towards them, "You must repent and each of you must be baptized on the name of Jesus Christ into (*the*) dismissal of your sins and you will receive the free-gift of the holy spirit, <sup>.39</sup>for the promise is to you and to your children and to all the (*people*) into distant-places as-many-as ever (*the*) Lord our God may call-towards-Himself,"
  - Acts 10:44-46:
    - <sup>.44</sup>Yet (*during*) Peter's uttering-forth these spoken-matters, the spirit, the holy (*spirit*), fell on all the (*people*) hearing the word; <sup>.45</sup>and the believers out-from circumcision, as-many-as went-together with Peter, were bewildered because the free-gift of the holy spirit was poured-out<sup>2</sup> also on the Gentiles, <sup>.46</sup>for they heard them uttering-forth with tongues and expressing-the-greatness-of God;

# How to receive holy spirit?

- All who believe regarding the Lord Jesus Christ receive the gift of holy spirit
  - Romans 10:8-10:
    - <sup>8</sup>...This is the spoken-matter of the belief which we herald-forth <sup>9</sup>that if-ever you may express-agreement in your mouth (*regarding the*) Lord Jesus Christ and you may believe in your heart that God raised him up out-from dead-people you will be saved; <sup>10</sup>for in (*the*) heart it is believed into righteousness and in (*the*) mouth agreement-is-expressed into salvation.



# Christ in you, the hope of glory

- The spirit of Christ is in all holy-people – the hope of glory
  - Colossians 1:27:
    - .27 to whom God intended to make-known what (*is*) the wealth of the glory of this mystery in the Gentiles which is 'Christ in you, the hope of the glory'

# Spirit of Life

- The gift of holy spirit gives life and spiritual thoughts
  - John 10:10:
    - <sup>.10</sup>The thief does not come except in order that he may steal and sacrifice and destroy; I came in order that they may have life and they may have an exceeding-thing.
  - Romans 8:1 and 2:
    - <sup>8:1</sup>Consequently now (*there is*) not-one condemning-sentence to the (*people*) in Christ Jesus, <sup>.2</sup>for the law of the spirit of the life in Christ Jesus freed you away-from the law of the sin and the death.

# Spirit of Sonship

- The gift of holy spirit makes us sons of God
  - Romans 8:14 and 15:
    - <sup>14</sup>for as-many-as are led by *(the)* spirit of God these-people are sons of God; <sup>15</sup>for you did not receive a spirit of slavery again into fear, but you received a spirit of sonship – in which we shout, "Abba, Father";
  - Galatians 4:4-7:
    - <sup>4</sup>but when the fullness of the time came God apostled-out His son, having come-into-being from a woman, having come-into-being under law <sup>5</sup>in order that he may redeem the *(people)* under law, in order that we may receive the sonship; <sup>6</sup>but *(since it is true)* that you are sons *(it is true that)* God apostled-out His spirit into our hearts shouting, "Abba, Father" – <sup>7</sup>so-that you are no-longer a slave but a son, but since *(you are)* a son *(you are)* also an inheritor by means of God.

# Spirit of ability, love, sound-thinking

- The gift of holy spirit gives us ability, love, and sound-thinking
  - II Timothy 1:7:
    - .7for God did not give to us a spirit of cowardice but of ability and love<sup>1</sup> and sound-thinking,

# The spirit manifests itself

- Paul teaches about the contributions from the gift of holy spirit
  - I Corinthians 12:7-11:
    - <sup>7</sup>But the manifestation of the spirit is given to each-person towards the-thing contributing,
    - <sup>8</sup>for indeed, for which (*contribution*) a word of wisdom is given by means of the spirit, but for another (*contribution*) a word of knowledge according to the same spirit, <sup>9</sup>but for a different (*contribution*) belief in the same spirit, but for another (*contribution*) gracious-gifts of healings in the spirit, <sup>10</sup>but for another (*contribution*) in-workings of ability, for another (*contribution*) prophecy, for another (*contribution*) through-judgments of spirits, for a different (*contribution*) genera of tongues, but for another (*contribution*) interpretation of tongues –
    - <sup>11</sup>but the one and the same spirit in-works all these, diverging to each-person according as it deliberately-determines,

# Fruit from the spirit

- We can take the fruit that the gift of holy spirit produces
  - Galatians 5:22 and 23:
    - .<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the spirit is: love<sup>1</sup>, joy, peace, patience, benevolence, goodness, belief, .<sup>23</sup>meeekness, self-control – against the things-of-this-kind there is not law,

# Pray in spirit

- We can pray in spirit
  - Jude 1:20 and 21:
    - .<sup>20</sup>But you, loved-people<sup>1</sup>, building yourselves on your holiest belief, praying in holy spirit, .<sup>21</sup>must keep yourselves in (*the*) love<sup>1</sup> of God waiting-for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ into eternal life;



# Behave according to the spirit

- We can walk in line with the gift of holy spirit
  - Galatians 5:16-18:
    - <sup>.16</sup>But I say: you must walk by spirit, and let you never complete (*the*) intense-yearning of flesh, <sup>.17</sup>for the flesh intensely-yearns against the spirit but the spirit (*is*) against the flesh, for these-things are adverse to one-another in order that you may not do these-things which if-ever you may intend; <sup>.18</sup>but since you are led by spirit you are not under law.
  - Galatians 5:25:
    - <sup>.25</sup>since we live with spirit, let us walk-in-line-with spirit,

# Soul verses Spirit

- The soulish man is different to the spiritual man
  - I Corinthians 2:14-16:
    - <sup>.14</sup>but a soulish man does not accept the-things of the Spirit of God for they are dullness to him and he is not able to know (*them*) because they are spiritually judged-up, <sup>.15</sup>but the spiritual-person judges-up all-things - but he is judged-up by not-one (*person or spirit*), <sup>.16</sup>for "Who knew (*the*) mind of (*the*) Lord, he-who will compact it together with (*his mind*)?" - but we have (*the*) mind of Christ.

# Spiritual Blessing

- Holy-people have been blessed with every spiritual blessing
  - Ephesians 1:3 and 4:
    - <sup>3</sup>Blessed (*is*) the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the (*One*) having blessed us in every spiritual blessing in the heavenlies in Christ <sup>4</sup>according as He selected us for-Himself in him before (*the*) throwing-down of (*the*) world (*for*) us to be holy and without-blemish down-before Him in love<sup>1</sup>,
